

Dear Students,

As for today there are no confirmed COVID-19 cases in Czestochowa.

Nevertheless, due to the spread of coronavirus in Europe, to prevent COVID-19 at CUT the Rector of the CUT decided to suspend all classes at least till March 29, 2020.

CUT administrative staff working hours remain unchanged, but entrance to all the CUS's buildings will be limited. Please contact via e-mail or phone in advance (contact details - below). We will try to respond as soon as possible.

All classes at the Czestochowa University of Technology are suspended (full-time, part-time classes, classes for doctoral students, participants of the doctoral school, post-graduate studies and courses) from 12th of March 2020 to 29th of March 2020.

Depending on changes in the epidemiological situation and decisions of state authorities, the period of suspension of activities may be extended.

Students in dormitories are requested to stay in them until their teaching is restored. No visitors allowed at the the student houses.

For foreign students, who decide to leave our country, we cannot guarantee that they will be able to return to the dormitory and we cannot indicate at the moment what procedures will be required in order to do so.

People who have come from the regions with reported confirmed cases of infection in the last 14 days, are asked to settle all matters, formalities or any other business by phone or e-mail, or by third parties without appearing in person at Czestochowa University of Technology, and avoid human gatherings or public places. It refers as well as the ones showing symptoms resembling those of flu.

In the event of symptoms of fever, cough, dyspnoea and breathing problems, sick people should remain at home and contact immediately the Sanitary-Epidemiological Station (+48 34 344 99 26 (00, 01)) or report directly to the observation and infectious ward - Provincial Specialist Hospital Blessed Virgin Mary, address: ul. PCK 7, Czestochowa (+48 34 367 38 73).

Explain any doubts about your health condition by PHONE or other methods of remote consultation. DO NOT GO TO MEDICAL CLINIC (unless you are asked to do so) or DO NOT GO TO THE HOSPITAL without prior arrangement.
