Order No. 201/2021 by the Rector of Czestochowa University of Technology of 17 November 2021

regarding: further activities of the University related to the coronavirus epidemic SARS-CoV-2 and conducting classes at Czestochowa University of Technology.

Following the guidelines of Polish Chief Sanitary Inspector and the Ministry of Science and Higher Education of 6 May 2021, and taking into account the necessity of preventing, counteracting and combating COVID-19 I hereby implement the rules concerning restricting access to buildings and conducting classes at Czestochowa University of Technology:

§ 1

1. Only a healthy person, without symptoms suggestive of an infectious disease (indicating a respiratory infection, e.g. cough, breathing difficulties, increased temperature over 37.5°C), may enter the University building.

2. All University employees, PhD students and participants of the doctoral school must wear their ID badges, which they should present on request at the entrance to the building. All University students are admitted to the University buildings on the basis of their ID cards.

3. In the University buildings it is absolutely obligatory to cover the mouth and the nose with a face mask, to disinfect hands and to keep a 1.5 meters distance from other people in accordance with the guidelines of Polish Chief Sanitary Inspectorate.

4. University employees are required to cover their mouth and the nose with a face mask in shared areas during direct contact, office meetings and cleaning work.

5. Students, PhD students, participants of the doctoral school are required to cover their mouth and the nose with a face mask in shared areas during dealing with matters in organizational units of the University.

6. During classes it is not obligatory to cover the mouth and nose with a mask.

§ 2

The other provisions by the Chancellor of Czestochowa University of Technology on restricting access to buildings shall remain in force.

§ 3

The order shall come into force on the date of its issue.
