History of the Faculty and its main areas of activity

The origins of the Faculty of Management go back to 1989, when Industry Organisation and Management degree programme was established at the Faculty of Machine Design. Two years later, the Department of Organisation and Management was founded at the same Faculty. It was then transformed into the Institute of Management and Marketing to become the Faculty of Management on 1 June 1997. The following years saw the establishment of the Advisory Board of Business

Representatives as well as the first publications of the 'Polish Journal of Management Studies' and „Zeszyty Naukowe Politechniki Częstochowskiej. Zarządzanie” (Research Reviews of Czestochowa University of Technology. Management). In 1998, the Faculty was granted the right to confer a PhD degree in Social Sciences in the discipline of Management and Quality Studies, and in 2011 it obtained the right to award a DSc degree in Social Sciences in the discipline of Management and Quality Studies.

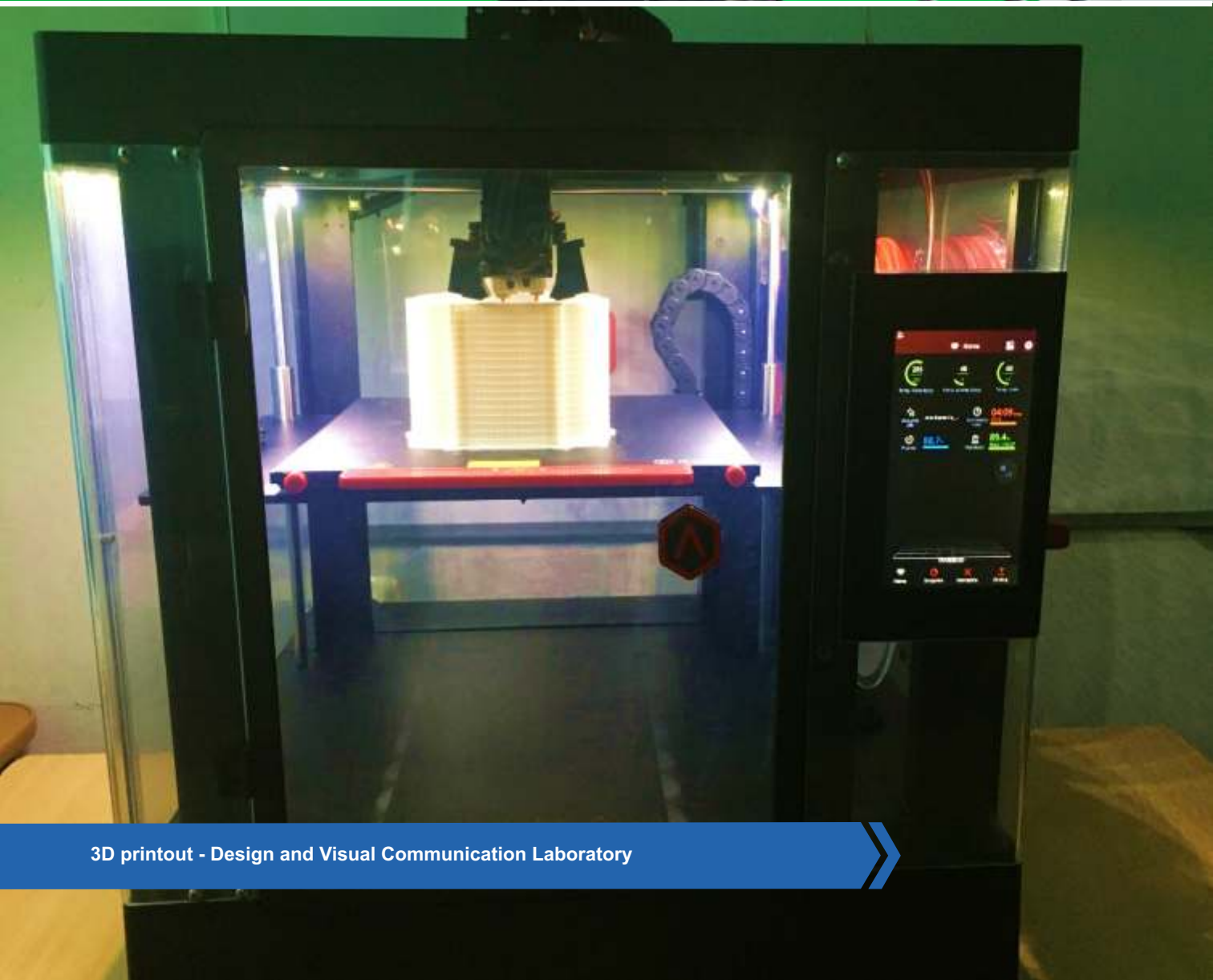

Facilities

The Faculty's scientific and research laboratories make it possible to conduct interdisciplinary research and development work aimed at implementing new technologies in the fields of: design, production, logistics and occupational safety and health. The Faculty boasts, among others, Packaging Laboratory, Design and Visual Communication Laboratory, and Laboratory of Ergonomics and Work Environment Development. They are equipped

with advanced IT systems for: simulation and optimisation of production and logistics processes, production of computer graphics as well as numerous educational tools used in management and accounting courses. The Faculty also has technical equipment for rapid product development and prototyping (CAD/CAM system, 3D Printing) and equipment for testing material properties for maximising product ergonomics and durability.

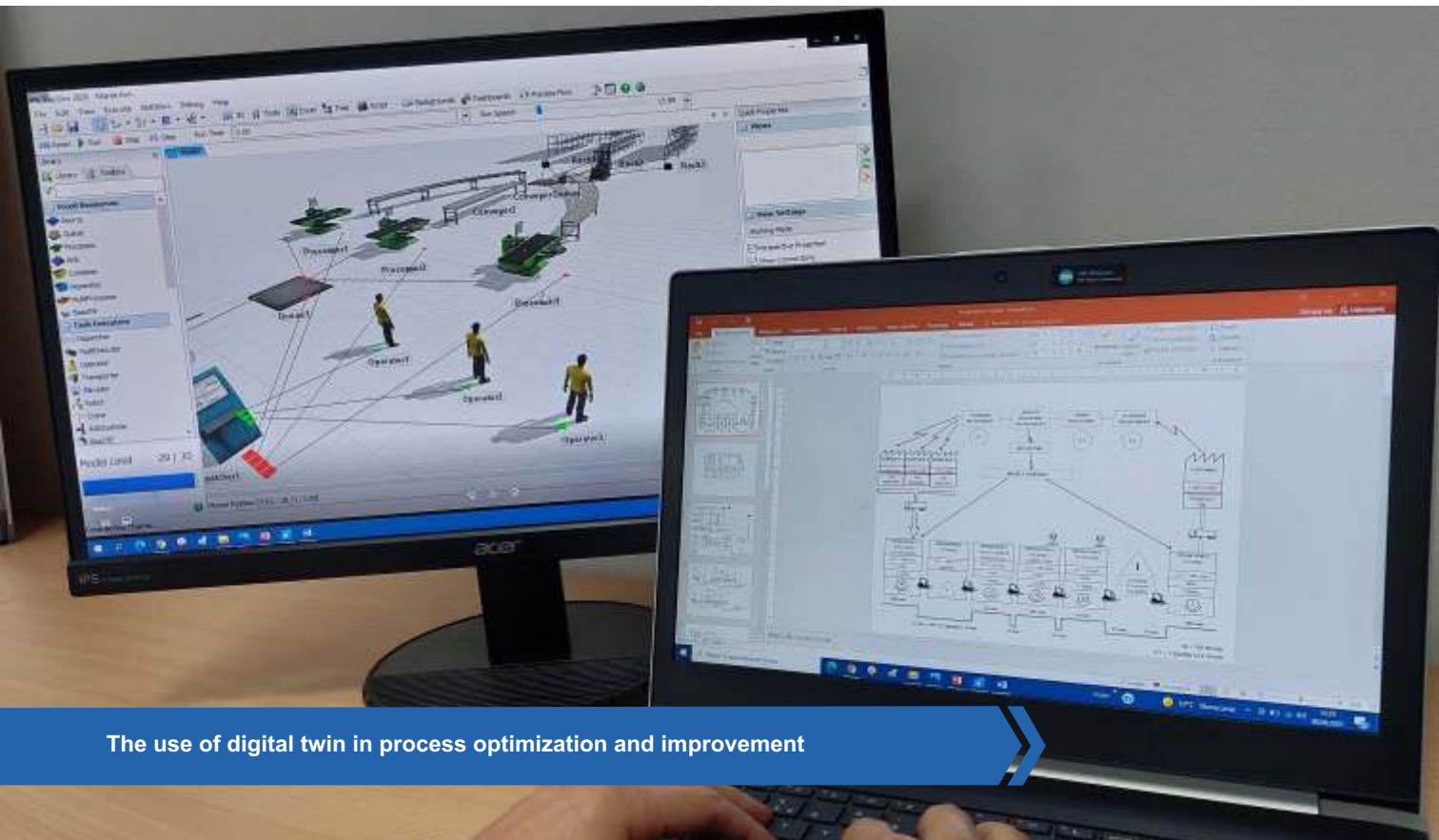

Educational offer

The educational offer of the Faculty meets the needs of the job market and fulfils students' expectations, ensuring the highest educational standards and integration of science and business. The Faculty offers full-time and part-time, first-cycle programmes (Bachelor's and Engineer's) as well as second-cycle programmes (Master's). The Faculty offers the following degree programmes: Management, Finance and Accounting in Business, Occupational Safety and Health, Logistics,

Engineering Logistics, Quality and Production Management, Business English, Design and Project Management, Tourism and Sport Management, as well as the following degree programmes in English: Management, Logistics, Quality and Production Management. The Faculty's involvement in the Erasmus+ programme enables students to complete part of their studies at universities abroad. The educational process is supported by laboratory facilities.

Student Research Clubs and other student activities

Students of the Faculty develop their interests and practical skills by taking an active part in 19 research clubs. Students' involvement in the clubs consists in conducting scientific research, publishing, and participating in conferences and meetings with representatives of science, culture and politics. The initiatives of research clubs have resulted in, among others: development of a board game prototype entitled 'Get to know the University of Technology', which shows student life in the form of an integrated

activity for present and future students. What is more, since 2017, students of the Student Research Club 'FaMa' Business Leaders Club have cyclically participated in the 'Winter Holidays with Economics' (Ferie z ekonomią), which is an educational project implemented by the European Fund for the Development of Polish Villages and the National Bank of Poland. The Scientific Society of Organization and Management (TNOiK) is yet another research club operating at the Faculty.

Cooperation with business

The Faculty cooperates with business and educational institutions as well as the local government. 2012 witnessed the establishment of the Advisory Board of Business Representatives at the Faculty initiated by partner companies. The cooperation with the Board enables the enrichment of the educational offer adjusted to the market needs and provides a database of internships and student work

placements. An example of this collaborative effort is the agreement with JOWES (the Jurassic Social Economy Support Centre), run by the Regional Development Agency S.A. in Czestochowa. The cooperation with the Czestochowa City Hall has resulted in the project 'Curious about the world. Curious about the future', organised as an urban game targeted at school children.

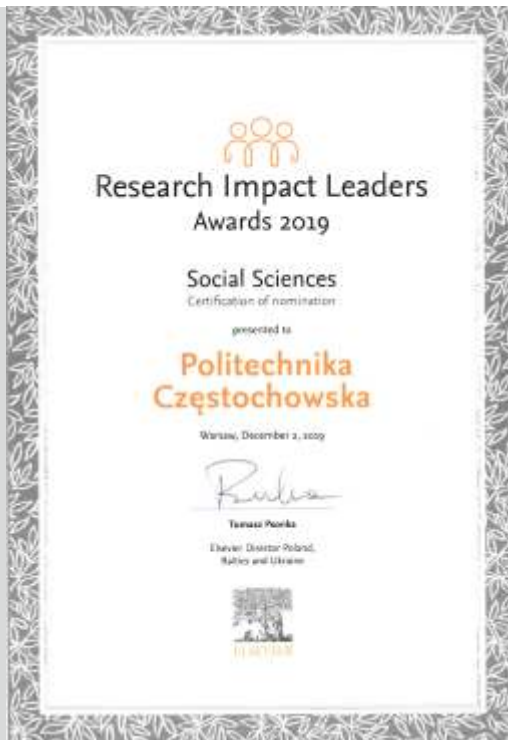




Significant accomplishments

The scientific as well as research and development work of the Faculty was highly assessed by the Evaluation Committee for Research Centres, which awarded the Faculty with the 'A' category in 2017. The Faculty programmes have been positively evaluated by the Polish Accreditation Committee. Thanks to the Faculty's staff, in 2019, the University was nominated for and, in 2020, honoured with the prestigious 'ELSEVIER Research Impact Leaders Awards 2020' in Social Sciences. The

award recognizes outstanding research institutions that have the largest impact on research and improve the visibility of Polish science around the world. The Faculty holds conferences indexed in the Web of Science database. Polish Journal of Management Studies (PJMS) is included in the MEiN (Ministry of Education and Science) list of ranked journals. The Faculty of Management staff have been presented with numerous awards and scholarships in Poland and abroad.
